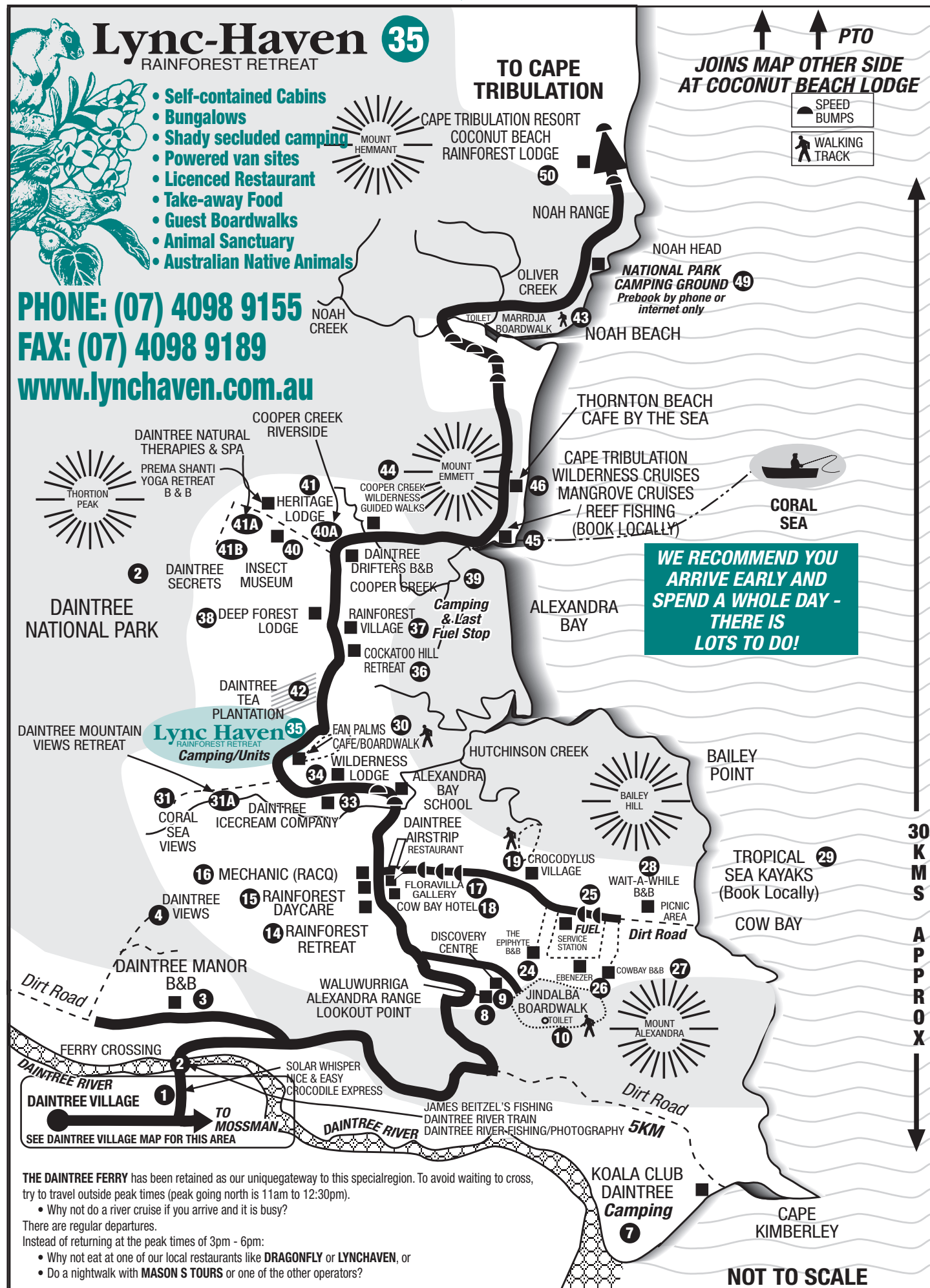


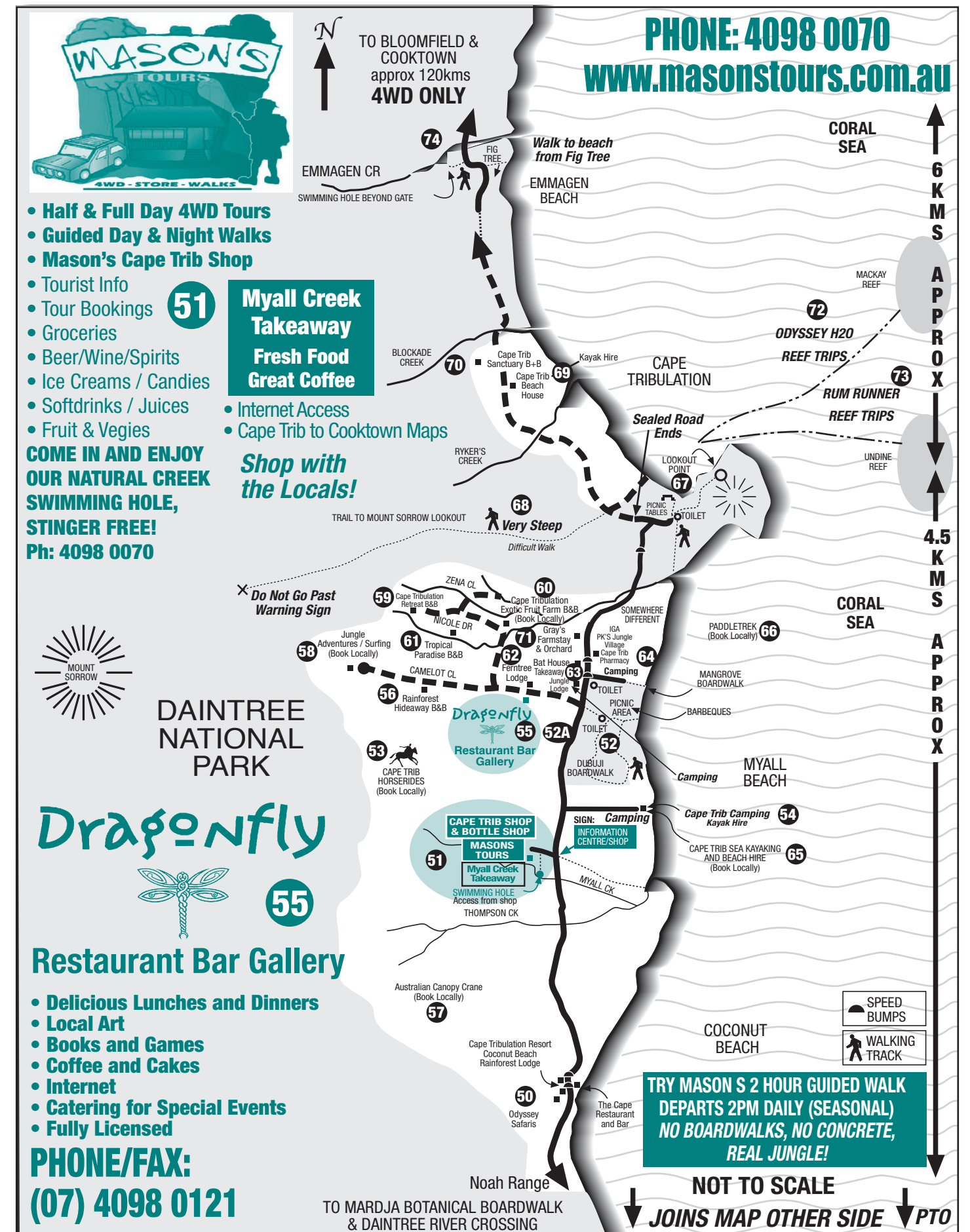
# FREE DAINTREE RIVER TO CAPE TRIBULATION MAP

The Daintree River to Cape Tribulation Area is amazing and well worth a day visit. It is the place where you can see the World's most Ancient Rainforest and it is one of the closest points to The Great Barrier Reef. There are numerous beautiful beaches. The Road to Cape Tribulation is sealed all the way and suitable for all cars. We recommend that you leave as early as possible for a Day trip, so you can enjoy the area for as long as possible. Come on, come 'over the River!!!' It is another world! Ferry hours 6am to midnight

The Daintree Ferry has been retained as our unique gateway to this special region. To avoid waiting to cross, try to travel outside peak times (northbound peak 11am - 12:30pm, southbound peak 3pm - 6pm). Why not visit an attraction or do a tour, or have a meal instead of waiting in the queue?

The Daintree has a local host community and your support of any local business is welcomed. Local landowners use tourism income to manage and protect their rainforest. It is widely recognized that managed tourism is a low impact way to utilize our precious rainforests.
